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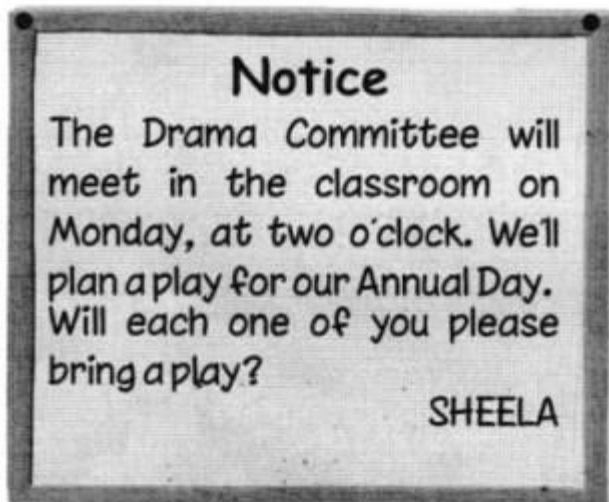
D. Find one story of bravery about a child. You can search for the story by talking to older people or watching a TV programme or from a film.
