

Blood Relations

- Blood Relation means any relation between two or more persons which is acquired by them by the virtue of their birth.
- Blood relation questions involve analysis of information showing the blood relationship among members of the family. In this, a chain of relationships is given in the form of information and on the basis of this information, relation between any two members of the chain is asked from the candidate. Candidates are supposed to be familiar with the knowledge of different relationships in the family.
- The relations may be divided into two main categories.

Maternal Relations Relations on the mother's side are called maternal. **Paternal Relations** Relations on the father's side are called paternal.

Sol. (d) Let us draw the family diagram,




Clearly, the only son of Gopal's father is Gopal himself. This means Gopal is the father of Govind.




Hints & Solutions

1. (a) The relationship diagram is as follows,




Clearly, the only son of Brijesh's father is Brijesh himself. This means Brijesh is the father of Alka. Hence, Alka is the daughter of Brijesh.

So, C is mother-in-law of D.

3. (b) The relationship diagram is as follows,




Clearly, sister of Suresh's father is Suresh's aunt and daughter of aunt is cousin. Hence, woman is the cousin of Suresh.

4. (c) The relationship diagram is as follows,




Clearly, Prabhu is the brother-in-law of Kusuma

5. (c) The relationship diagram is as follows,




Husband of Amit's wife is Amit himself. So, the woman is the sister of amit.

6. (a) The relationship diagram is as follows,




The only child of persons's father is the person himself. So, the man in photograph is his own son.


So, Moni is niece of my wife.

9. (d) The relationship diagram is as follows,





10. (c) The relationship diagram is as follows,





11. (c) The relationship diagram is as follows,





12. (a) The relationship diagram is as follows,





13. (c) The relationship diagram is as follows,




So, it is clear that Rajesh is the father-in-law of Rajan.
