The University has adopted CUET exam for all the Under Graduation courses . In order to take admission into any of the 15 UG courses of Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, candidates must appear for CUET 2023 exam. The fifteen courses Under Graduate course at Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University are, B.Sc. Life Sciences, B.A Public Administration (Hons, B.Voc Floriculture and Landscape Gardening, B.Com (Hons), BBA, BBA LLB, D. Pharma, BCA, Diploma in ECCE, B.Sc Geology (Hons), Integrated B.Sc-M.Sc, B.A (Optional-History, Political Science, Public Administration, Sociology, Economics, English), B.Sc Food Science & Technology, B.Sc IT, B.Com. Various campuses of the University offer the aforementioned UG courses.

Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University was founded in the year 1996. The University was ranked as 76 in the management ranking by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). The varsity has a satellite campus at Amethi, which was started by BBAU in 2016.

Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University UG Admission 2023 through CUET Application process

The students who will qualify CUET 2023 entrance examination and are willing to take in Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University must go through the stepwise application process for filling the admission form. The students can check some of the common and important steps to apply for Babasaheb Bhimrao Amedkar University UG admission 2023.

- Step 1: The students need to visit the official website of the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University at https://bbaucuet.samarth.edu.in/
- Step 2: Click on 'New Registration' on the homepage of the official link. If any student is already registered, then they can login directly by entering the login credentials.
- Step 3: For 'New Registration' a link will be opened and students will be redirected to the student's registration form.
- Step 4: They can register by using CUET Application Number and date of birth as mentioned in class Xth marks sheet. The students will be asked to enter the given captcha to complete the process of registration.
- Step 5: The students can login to the admission portal through their registered email address only. They must use their active email address for the purpose of admission.
- Step 6: Once the students are able to login, they must fill the required information and documents as per the given specifications. The student must ensure that all the information given is accurate and relevant as the same will be cross checked at the time of document verification. If any discrepancy is found the application form will be rejected.
- Step 7: The students must pay the desired application fee in order to complete the registration process and submit the application form.
- Step 8: Download the application fee receipts and take printouts of the submitted application form for any future reference.
