Mahatma Gandhi Central University Application Process 2023

Candidates interested in attending Mahatma Gandhi Central University must appear for the CUET (UG) for the selected courses. Candidates who are qualified in the CUET UG 2023 are eligible to apply for the courses offered through CUET. The following is a step-by-step procedure for completing the application form of MGCU.

Visit the official admission portal of MGCU
at <https://mgcubcuetsamarth.edu.in/index.php>. or Click on the direct link provided above.

Click on the link called 'New Registration'

A new registration window will be opened and the instructions to fill out the application form will be displayed.

Read the instruction carefully which are provided left side of the page and start with your registration process.

Complete the registration process by entering the 'CUET UG Application Number', 'Date of Birth', and 'Captcha Code'.

Then click on the option called 'Register'

Fill out the application form of MGCU UG Admissions 2023

Pay the application fee.

Download the application form and take a printout.

Mahatma Gandhi Central University Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for Mahatma Gandhi Central University UG Admission 2023 through CUET. The university provides BA courses at the undergraduate level, in addition to BCom (Hons) and BTech. The BA programme is three years long. Mahatma Gandhi Central University UG CUET eligibility criteria 2023 course wise has been mentioned below.

Candidates must have completed a recognised education board's class 12 examination or an equivalent examination recognised by the education board, or Senior Secondary (12th grade of the 10+2 system) in any stream.

The applicant must have completed class 12th with a minimum grade point average of 50%.

Applicants for admission to MGCU 's undergraduate programme must take the Common University Entrance Test (CUET).

The final decision will be made based on the results of the CUET exam, which will be followed by counselling.

In addition to this, course-wise Mahatma Gandhi Central University UG admission eligibility criteria along with their respective fee have been tabulated below:

Course	Eligibility Criteria	Fees
BA	Class 12 or equivalent qualification from a recognised educational board in any stream with a minimum aggregate of 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD applicants).	INR 35,454
BCom (Hons)	Passed Class 12 with Accounting/Business Mathematics as one of the subjects with a minimum aggregate of 55% (50% for ST/ST/OBC candidates) from a recognised Board.	INR 35,454
BTech	Passed Class 12 with a minimum aggregate of 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD applicants) in Physics and Mathematics, as well as any one of the subjects (Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology / Technical Vocational) with a minimum aggregate of 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates).	INR 2,00,000

Mahatma Gandhi Central University UG Admission Process

Undergraduate students are admitted to Mahatma Gandhi Central University depending on their qualifying examination performance. There will be a CUET Entrance Examination for UG Courses Admission for some undergraduate degree programmes, as admissions will be provided based on the score attained in the CUET 2023 entrance examination. Following the announcement of the CUET 2023 results, the University will release a list of shortlisted UG candidates. The merit

list will be made available to all registered candidates at that time. The names of those who have been shortlisted for the counselling procedure, as well as their rank, will appear on the merit list. Candidates will also be called to the counselling procedure based on their admissions merit list position.

The CUET 2023 merit list will also be published by the CUET participating universities. Candidates who have met the cut-off scores and rank and are qualified for counselling are listed on the merit list. Candidates should be informed that the minimal requirements for relevant subjects vary based on the participating university.

Candidates chosen for various UG programmes from the CUET 2023 merit list must attend an online/offline counselling session at a participating university. Finally, the admission screening committee will make the final choice.
