

Mizoram University UG Admission through CUET

Mizoram University Admission 2023

The university uses general selection criteria that are based on merit or entrance exam results. For programmes such as BTech and BArch, the institution recognises the scores/ranks of several national/state level entrance exams. In addition, MZU offers a university-level entrance exam (MZU-EEE) that allows students to enrol in a desired course even if they have not taken any of the accepted entry exams.

Mizoram University Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for Mizoram University UG Admission 2023 through CUET. The university provides various courses at the undergraduate level, in addition to BArch and BTech. The BA programme is three years long. Mizoram University UG CUET eligibility criteria courses wise has been mentioned below.

Candidates must have completed a recognised education board's class 12 examination or an equivalent examination recognised by the education board, or Senior Secondary (12th grade of the 10+2 system) in any stream.

The applicant must have completed class 12th with a minimum grade point average of 50%.

Applicants for admission to MZU 's undergraduate programme must take the Common University Entrance Test (CUET).

The final decision will be made based on the results of the CUET exam, which will be followed by counselling.

Mizoram University Diploma Courses

Handloom weaving and beekeeping are two of the vocational courses and diplomas offered by Mizoram University. The length of these programmes ranges from six to 36 months. These courses are available in a full-time format. Candidates can apply for admission to these courses if they have finished Class 12 at a school recognised by a state or national board. Candidates with a background in the relevant field of study will be given preference. Students accepted into these courses are eligible for a stipend of Rs 1,000 per month. The total number of seats available for the Handloom Weavers and BeeKeeper courses is 50 (combined) and 25 for the BeeKeeper course.

Mizoram University Application Process 2023

Candidates must register online and submit an application form to be considered for admission to Mizoram University. The application form can be found on the university's official website. A PDF will be generated once the registration procedure is completed. Print out the completed application form and mail it to the university's admissions office along with the relevant documentation.

How to apply for Mizoram University?

To apply for UG admission at Mizoram University, follow the steps below:

To apply for admission to Mizoram University, go to the college's official website and create an account.

Complete the online application form with all of the relevant information. After you've submitted the form, you won't be able to make any changes.

To finish the application process, applicants must pay a fee of INR 700 (INE 350 for SC/ST candidates).

A PDF will be generated after you submit the online form. Take a printout and mail it to the following location, together with the relevant documents mentioned below.

The following is a list of documents that must be submitted at the time of application:

Mark sheets and certificates for classes 10 and 12

Certificate of completion of a bachelor's or master's degree (if applicable)

Scorecard for the relevant entrance exam

Photo identification is required.

MZU UG 2023 Admission Process

Undergraduate students are admitted to MZU based on their success on their qualifying examinations. For select undergraduate degree programmes, there will be a CUET Entrance Examination for UG Courses Admission, as admissions will be granted based on the score obtained in the CUET 2023 entrance examination.

The University will provide a list of shortlisted UG candidates following the announcement of the CUET 2023 results. At that time, the merit list will be made available to all registered candidates. The merit list will include the names of those who have been shortlisted for the counselling procedure, as well as their rank. Candidates will be called to the counselling process based on their placement on the admissions merit list.

The CUET participating universities will also release the CUET 2023 merit list. On the merit list, candidates who have met the cut-off scores and rank and are eligible for counselling are listed. Candidates should be aware that the minimum requirements for relevant disciplines change depending on the university they apply to.

Candidates selected for various UG programmes from the CUET 2023 merit list must attend an online/offline counselling session at one of the participating universities. The ultimate decision will be made by the admission screening committee.
